Introduction of University

Higher education is the most critical element of growth in this era of knowledge economy. We need to at least double the Gross Enrollment Ratio (GER) to remain active contributors to growth in this era. This truth has been well recognised by many policy planners, commissions and thoughtful individuals. The National Knowledge Commission has brought out valuable documents outlining the critical role of higher education. In this context, the role of Open and Distance Learning System (ODL) becomes significant and unique. The experience across the globe substantiates that ODL system is an effective tool for educationally empowering the different sections of society who, for one reason or the other, had missed the formal 'face-to-face' education. These days, distance education provides many vocational, professional and technical courses, including specialized programmes oriented towards the higher end of technology usage. It also has the potential to reach the unreached, marginalized and excluded people residing in distant places and difficult terrain. Strictly in tune with the philosophy of ODL system, Uttarakhand Open University (UOU) was established by an Act of Legislative Assembly in 2005 23 Uttarakhand (Act No. on 31.10.2005 with the aim of disseminating knowledge and skills through distance learning, using the flexible and innovative methods of education to ensure 'Independent Learning'.

The major objective of the University is to cater to the educational needs of the target groups to create skilled and knowledge based human resource for speedy upliftment and development of the State. The University aims to impart quality education by maintaining high academic standards. For this purpose, it has radically reoriented itself in view of the rapid changes in the sphere of professional and technical education and has developed a number of new and innovative self-employment/ employment oriented courses of study. Programme's mission

The aim of the M. Ed. Special Education- ODL programme is of preparing teachers in the field of as special educational leaders. The major thrust of the M. Ed. Spl. Ed. programme would be professional preparation of special teacher educators who would through this process be equipped with the knowledge and competencies to facilitate and conduct initial preparation and continuing professional development in the field of specialeducation. They would need to be necessarily equipped with the core competencies and knowledge related to special teacher education, its philosophical underpinnings, researchmethodology, curriculum planning and be aware of best practices in the field of pedagogical interventions and adaptations for special teacher educator and children with disabilities. A person qualified in M.Ed. Special Education can serve as Master Trainer to teach Special Educators undergoing training at Diploma or Graduation levels in Special Education in specific disability. In addition, they can assume the role of Researchers, Leaders, Capacity Builders, Developer and Catalysts in the area of special education and Special teacher Education.M.Ed.Spl.Ed.(VI) programme the students will:

Programme's Objectives: The M. Ed. Special Education-ODL programme promotes three shared philosophical stances that underlying the longstanding tradition of preparing teacher educators to be education leaders. Teaching as inquiry, teaching as curriculum creation, and teaching for social justice are examples of these stances. The program's goals are as follows:

- Assist potential special teacher educators in taking the lead in advocating for and meeting the educational needs of children with disabilities in a variety of settings.
- Provide opportunities for teacher educators to gain specialized leadership skills in curriculum, pedagogy, and universal design in special education area.

• Build theoretical knowledge and skills in research methodologies and conducting research in order to enhance education of children with disabilities in all settings.

Rules and Regulations for Admission of M.Ed. Spl. Ed. (IDD/HI/VI) ODL Programme

Eligibility-

- A candidate who has successfully passed B.EdSpl.Edu. with minimum 50% marks in respective disability area from a recognized university or any other degree considered equivalent to B.EdSpl. Ed. from an affiliating university and/ or teaching department under any University recognized by U.G.C. with RCI registration.
- A candidate who has successfully passed the B.Ed. General course and has successfully completed Diploma in Special Education in respective disability area recognized by the Rehabilitation Council of India with minimum 50 percent marks in each course.
- A candidate with B.A/B.Sc/B.Com B.Ed-Spl.Edn (4 years integrated)
- Candidate should have valid RCI registration.
- Admission shall be made through entrance test and merit list.
- The reservation and relaxation of marks for the Reserve Category candidates shall be as per the rules of Government of Uttarakhand.

Duration:

The M.Ed. program shall be of duration of two and half academic years (Five semesters). Students shall be permitted to complete the program-requirements of the two and half year duration within a maximum period of five academic years from the date of admission in the program.

Intake-

105 (One hundred five only only) approved by RCI and UGC-DEB Reservation of total seats will be as per existing State Govt. Rules. Course will run only in University Headquater at Haldwani and NIEPVD Dehradun.
